

The Rainbow Camps volunteers' scheme

We always need people to help set up the site, maintain it during the events and then pack it away again afterwards. In exchange you get to be an essential part of the event, gain all sorts of useful experience, meet great people, eat delicious food and generally work hard, have a good time and go home with a warm glow.

If you are interested in volunteering for site work we particularly need people with the following skills:

- General helpers
- Site plumbing experience
- Running the sauna and showers
- Cooking and feeding the site crew
- Structure erection – marquees, yurts etc.
- First Aid certificate
- Driving license

There are a variety of ways that being part of the site crew can work for you....

1) The set up:

Arriving 5 days before the event to help set up the Rainbow Camps site, You work full on till the start of the event, helping to create the magic that becomes a Rainbow Camp. This would involve the setting up of marquees and other structures, Big Lodge – Yurt – Domes. Toilets and Water world. Site decoration.

2) The Move:

Between the Druid camp and Super Spirit we have to take the whole lot down and move it to a new site (this is due to legal requirements for out door events such as ours) We need plenty of help at this stage and allow ourselves 10 days to complete this.

3) Pack Down:

This is when we take it all down and pack it away until next year. We always need a lot of support at this stage to carefully take down the site and leave the field as we found it, clean and green!

4) During a camp:

Each camp needs an on site team to help with the day to day running of the camp “Domestics” these include

Water world – showers sauna and toilets

Staffing the gate- welcoming people into each camp

Central fire and evening lighting up

Litter picking
Cafe

Hours put in helping out in the **Set up, Move or Pack down** can be offset against time spent at a camp of your choice.

During a camp we ask for 4 hours work (this is a maximum and may be less) in exchange for each day at the camp
